## **2024 Future Research Talent (FRT) program - Information sheet**

### **---For institutional staff managing selection process only. Not for distribution to applicants---**

- FRT is a competitive program open to staff and students from selected, high-quality Indonesian institutions. For the 2024 FRT round, we are expecting to be able to support a total of ~25 Indonesian scholars, selected from across 14 collaborating Indonesian institutions.
- All applicants must be nominated by ANU's selected collaborating institutions in Indonesian. The link to the application portal, along with your institution's unique nomination IDs, is provided in a separate attachment.
  - A limited number of nomination IDs for student and/or staff categories will be provided to each institution. Every nomination ID is unique and can only be used to submit one application.
  - Please exercise caution when providing the application link and nomination IDs to your students / staff. These should **not** be shared publicly. You may apply on behalf of your students.
- Research Projects across various disciplinary areas at ANU that are available as part of the 2024 FRT scheme are listed on the [FRT webpage](#). Applicants must nominate at least one, but can nominate up to three, research projects from that list in their FRT application.
- Important: Applicants are ***NOT*** required or expected to contact ANU supervisors/academic staff during the application process. Please advise your students / staff that pre-approval from academic staff at ANU is ***not*** necessary for this program and that ANU academic staff should ***not*** be contacted.
  - Applicants are also required to provide the following as part of the application.
    - Two academic reference letters (these can be submitted through the online application portal or emailed directly to ANU – instructions are contained in the online application portal)

- Copy of their most recent transcripts (providing an overview of their cumulative GPA and courses taken as part of their degree program/s)
  - An updated resume/CV
  - Evidence of English language ability (this can be done by providing a copy of results in a standardised English language test (e.g., IELTS, TOEFL, etc.) or a copy of written work in English (e.g., a research paper) or a one-minute self-recorded video demonstrating English language proficiency.
  
- The online application for the FRT program is a short, three-part application. If you would like to view the application form or the questions we ask, please see the attached document containing screenshots of the online application form, including all questions that applicants will be asked in the form.
  
- We strongly encourage you to nominate your best students and staff who have demonstrated an excellent aptitude for research. We are looking to support Indonesia's future research talent and you are strongly encouraged to run an internal selection process to select your students / staff accordingly. You are requested to rank your nominated scholars and we may use that ranking (e.g., as a tiebreaker) if required.
  - 13 ANU Research Schools have nominated over 110 research projects / areas / groups that are open to hosting FRT scholars in 2024. You are encouraged to nominate students / staff across the research and educational spectrum of your institution that aligns with the ANU research projects / areas / groups that are open to hosting candidates.
  - The number of scholars that we select in each discipline area is very likely to correspond to research projects available in that discipline as listed on the [FRT webpage](#) – you may wish to consider this in your internal selections (particularly if you are a multi-disciplinary institution).
  
- The FRT program is designed primarily to support senior undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate (PG) students, and academic / research staff who are yet to complete a PhD but, who have demonstrated excellent research capabilities and conducted a reasonable level of research work in their studies.
  - **Students** should ideally have at least one (1) year remaining in their degree program after returning to Indonesia following the completion of the 2024 FRT program. Therefore, students who will be entering or will already be in the penultimate stages of their Bachelor or Master degrees by mid-2024 will be best suited for the program. As a guide, candidates that you see reaching the following stages of their degrees by mid-2024 should be nominated:
    - *Students undertaking a 4-year UG program should be completing the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of their degree by mid-2024.*

- *Students undertaking a 5-year integrated UG+PG program should be completing the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year of their degree by mid-2024.*
  - *Students undertaking a 2-year PG / Master degree program should be completing the 1<sup>st</sup> year of their degree by mid-2024.*
- PhD candidates may be nominated but only for research projects that are identified on the [FRT webpage](#) with \* asterisk (denoting they are available to candidates currently pursuing PhD). PhD candidates nominated for all other projects will not be considered.
  - **Staff** who hold Bachelor or Master degree are best suited. Research projects / areas / groups that are open to hosting both staff and students are identified on the [FRT webpage](#) with # symbol, and those that are open *only* to staff (from specific universities) by % symbol.
- For exceptional applicants and where appropriate (i.e., both the applicant and ANU supervisor have availability), research projects marked with ^ symbol may be extended, and supported with additional funding, beyond the standard duration (12 weeks) of the FRT program. Applicants will be able to nominate their interest in an extended research project as part of their FRT application.
  - Please do not nominate candidates that you are aware have already accepted corporate (non-R&D related) job offers at the conclusion of their degree. Our aim is to support scholars that have a passion for research and are interested in developing a career in scientific research.
  - We are committed to addressing the under-representation of women in science, technology and mathematics disciplines. We encourage you to especially reach out to your female students and empower and support them to apply for the 2024 FRT program. We are aiming to select a gender-balanced pool of FRT scholars.
  - Applications are now open, and close on **20 November 2023**. All applicants should have been shortlisted by their home institute, provided with a unique nomination ID, and must have applied through the ANU online portal before this date.
  - Academic reference letters being emailed directly to ANU must be received by us by **27 November 2023** (these details are also provided in the online application form).
    - We aim to notify successful scholars before the end of January 2024. It is suggested that candidates undertake their research project at ANU between June - September 2024 unless another timeframe is negotiated with the host ANU Research School / supervisor.
