TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR ARCF APPLICATION

1 Background

The ASEAN Research Collaborative Fund (ARCF) was established in 2020 to support collaborative research efforts among medical schools of the ASEAN Medical School Network (AMSN).

2 Objectives

The goal of the ARCF is to support research collaborative activities among the participating AMSN members by providing travel grants and organizing research symposiums. These research collaborative activities are envisaged to lead to the betterment of health for the ASEAN community through exchanges in scientific knowledge, talent, research data, and expertise across the region.

3 Rules & Regulations

- 3.1 Application is open to all staff in the Faculty of Medicine, UM.
- 3.2 Application is either for a travel grant or research symposium.
- 3.3 For travel grant, should be research-related with the aim of increasing collaboration and networking between AMSN members.
- 3.4 For research symposium, should be aimed at generating new research collaborations between AMSN institutions

4 Duration of the Project

Up to two (2) months for a travel grant

5 Guidelines for the application process

- 5.1 Applicants are required to submit their applications and all related attachments in softcopy to resfom@um.edu.my in one PDF format.
- 5.2 Each AMSN institution may submit ONE application per year through their respective Deans.
- 5.3 Applications are restricted to travel between AMSN member institutions.
- 5.4 Each AMSN institution may submit a maximum of one travel grant application per year. There is no limit on the number of faculty members included in one travel grant application. The maximum amount of each travel grant application is US\$5,000.
- 5.5 Priority will be given to collaborative projects involving member institutions from multiple ASEAN countries. Additionally, applicants are encouraged to clearly articulate the potential impact of their research, emphasizing its role in addressing regional issues and fostering collaboration within the ASEAN community.
- 5.6 All applications will be evaluated based on their objective(s), feasibility, novelty, impact, and budget. Successful applicants will be notified following the conclusion of the selection process.

6 Proposed budget

Expenses covered under the ARCF Travel Grant include registration/course fees, accommodation/lodging, and transportation (air & ground). The maximum amount of each travel grant application is US\$5,000. Individual rates are as follows:

Up to one (1) week – maximum US\$1,000/member

Up to one (1) month – maximum US\$3,000/member

Up to two (2) months – maximum US\$5,000/member

Details should be provided for the ARCF Research Symposium. The maximum amount for each research symposium grant is capped at US\$10,000.

 - 7.2.6 Percentage of allocated amount that had been spent
 - 7.2.7 Problems/Constraints
